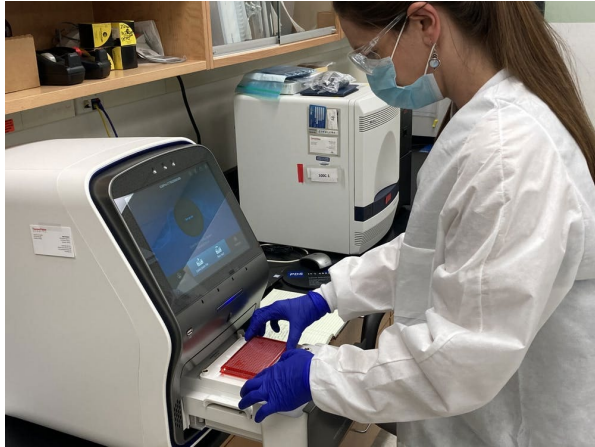


# GENETICS AND GENOMICS UNDERGRADUATE DISTINGUISHED RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS 2021



## INTERESTED IN YOUR OWN RESEARCH FUNDING?

The Laboratory of Genetics will provide up to \$6,000 to individual UW Genetics and Genomics undergraduate majors to support research projects in UW faculty laboratories. The funds will be administered by the student's faculty advisor. The funds may be used for stipend, research supplies, travel to professional conferences, and other research expenses.

### Eligible applicants:

All UW-Madison Genetics and Genomics undergraduate majors working in research laboratories on campus with a faculty research advisor are eligible. Students can receive this award only one time.

### Expectations:

At completion of the research project, the student is required to submit a two-page project report to the department awards committee on their findings. The students are also expected to present their research in a public forum as a poster, talk or a manuscript submitted for publication. The funds must be used within one year after the date of the award.
